**College/Career Prep:** Students participate in our annual Clark College day, which provides general information on how to research and apply to college, pursue scholarships, and more. Clark College has a staff advisor who assists with their high school credit profile and future college requirements. FFCHS provides information for SAT and ACT testing opportunities and upcoming regional college fairs. FFCHS currently subscribes to WOIS (Washington Occupational Information System), an on-line career information center that is available to our high school students and their families.

**School Leadership:** There are numerous opportunities for high school student leadership throughout the school year. Our high school students have been involved in setting up assemblies, hosting the Mother’s Tea, selling morning coffee, assisting at the auction, planning School Spirit Week, and more. Students actively participate in developing the yearbook each year. Our high school promotes servant leadership and encourages students to play an active roll in all school functions.

**Internships:** FFCHS promotes hands-on “work experience” through our internship program. On enrichment Wednesdays, it is possible for students to have an on-the-job internship at a local business or non-profit agency. This work based learning experience promotes the development of work place skills, real life responsibilities, and financial stewardship. Students can fulfill the occupational education credit requirement through an internship.

**Chapels:** High school students gather every Thursday morning for chapel which includes music, prayer, and a message by a local pastor.

**School/Community Opportunities:** School electives provide many extracurricular activities, such as musical performances on-site and in the community, service projects or activities, contests (Spelling Bee, speech meet), theatrical productions, catering of events, and more!

**Student Lounge:** High school students have the privilege of a separate room (the student lounge) that can be used before school, after school, during lunch and during class breaks. The high school students are responsible for cleaning, decorating, providing games and activities, and monitoring their own behavior.

Past socials have included things such as: overnigher at the Oregon Aquarium in Newport, Rock Solid Teen Center, bowling, Lewisville Park outing, a marshmallow roast at a staff member's house and more!
